Greetings to all our family, friends, supporters, and prayer warriors!

Thank you for your faithful prayers and generous financial support. There are no words that can fully express our feelings, so we give thanks from a grateful heart and pray God's richest blessing on you all.

In our last letter we requested prayer for us as we attended Truck World 2024 at the International Centre in Toronto on April 18–20. We had the privilege of interacting with numerous drivers who stopped by our booth (right).



Truck World was the perfect location for TFC to launch a new driver initiative, the NEVER ALONE campaign, to remind drivers that they are never alone in their journey. The campaign features a website, DriverMatter.ca, and an online/on call chaplain available at all times. To launch the campaign, cards were distributed with the campaign information (right) and one free YETI mug, branded with the campaign name and website, was given away every hour (far right). Over the three days 39 mugs were given away.

Thank you for your prayers—we could not do this without the support of God's people.

Sharing briefly from our Daily Chapel Logs:

In April, we had 23 visitors, 33 encounters in the parking lot/plaza and handed out 38 ministry materials.

- Driver Terry came in for a visit asking for prayer.
- A driver stopped in for an hour and shared a number of family concerns which we prayed about.
- Trucker Ranjib came in and we had a long chat about his beliefs as a Sikh; on his way out he asked for a copy of the Bible and we gladly gave him one as well as other booklets. He thanked us for a good conversation.
- Jim dropped in for fellowship, a devotional and prayer.
- Mark came into the chapel and poured out his heart. We talked and prayed together and he left encouraged, taking a magazine and the Never Alone card.
- I met Ken in the restaurant; he told me he was grateful he'd found someone who would listen to him.



In May we had 17 visitors, 37 encounters in the parking lot/plaza and handed out 47 ministry materials.

- Driver Norm dropped in to ask prayer for his family.
- I was able to give away copies of the Punjabi Gospel of John; one driver asked where we found it.
- Steve came in for a visit; he left a donation and asked for prayer. He thanked us for our mission.
- Upon arrival at the chapel we found a plastic bag hanging on the door knob; it had a note saying "Thank You" and two US \$20.00 bills inside.
- I was able to have short visits with drivers in the yard and thanked them for being out there; one of them said that God would bless us for what we do.

In June we had 8 visitors, 23 encounters in parking lot/plaza and handed out 27 ministry materials.

- I met a driver in the restaurant and we had a good visit; I prayed for his meal and he thanked me for that.
- I took a walk in the yard and gave away 9 magazines.
- Two East Indian saw the chapel and came in and I was able to share the Gospel with them.
- Shawn dropped in to talk and I listened to him for a good half hour. He felt the presence of God and asked God to forgive him and help him resist all temptations. Now he knows that God loves him and that he has been forgiven. We prayed together and he hugged me and thanked me. He felt the peace of God when he left. Praise the Lord for a soul set free!

On a personal note, we celebrated our **65th wedding anniversary** on June 21, 2024. Through the good times and the difficult times, God has been faithful.

Just for your information, we will not be having a Fall Fund Raising dinner this year. We do plan to have one, Lord willing, in the spring of 2025.
