This will greatly simplify residence in Germany as we locate there in October. Next comes applying for a passport, but that's a relatively quick process.

Ethiopia and a Vision Trip to North Africa with 5 Mission Leaders

God blessed Terry with another very fruitful time in Ethiopia in May and June. **A few highlights** in addition to his ongoing mentoring and coaching opportunities were:

- meeting with two Ethiopian couples who have expressed interest in working in North Africa and the Horn.
- encouraging forward movement with planning for the African Leadership Journey, due to launch next summer.
- a new mentee.
- new connections with the leader of a large youth missions movement and with the missions leader of another large denomination focused on sending workers to North Africa.
- an encouraging offsite with the mission leaders from the Ethiopian Kale Heywet Church.
- a deepened understanding of the deeply complex challenges of addressing tribalism in the Ethiopian church, both at home, and for missions.

One of the most significant highlights from this trip is an opportunity God has provided to facilitate a **vision trip to North Africa in December** for mission leaders of five of Ethiopia's largest denominations, all of whom want to send workers to North Africa. The planning is still in its earliest stages, but **please pray** for God's leading and provision to make this trip possible.

Transition to Germany - update

We want to **thank you** so much for praying about our support situation as we prepare to move to Germany. We're so grateful for the generous response we've received. We now have over 1/3 of our transition expenses, and need only \$365 more in monthly support.
