ABOUT OUR COMMUNITY

Tillsonburg is a town of approximately 21,000 people in Oxford County in southwestern Ontario. It is primarily a rural community, but it has recently seen a lot of growth, with several new subdivisions being developed around town. In 2023 it was the fastest growing community in Canada according to Realtor.ca. Tillsonburg is unique in that it has two communities built solely for seniors. Our population is becoming more ethnically diverse, and our mission field becoming more varied.



Generosity Challenge

Tillsonburg offers a balance between small-town community support and the exciting feeling of metropolitan growth. While providing stability for those in retirement, it also offers many well-developed recreational programs and facilities for all generations. The Tillsonburg Community Centre functions as a hub for the coordination of house league and travel team sports.

Tillsonburg has five elementary schools and one high school, as well as an adult learning center. Our High School maintains seventeen departments of education and offers regionally notable extracurricular opportunities in the areas of sports and music. There are also elementary Christian schools near Tillsonburg.

The Tillsonburg Town Centre houses a moderately sized shopping mall, and our downtown supports many local small businesses that lend vitality and provide stimulus to the growing local economy by bridging rural and urban interests. There is also a hospital in Tillsonburg that offers a variety of services and care.

While the town of Tillsonburg provides many necessary amenities locally, it is also situated near both London and Kitchener/Waterloo, which are 45 minutes to an hour's drive away for more specified shopping, recreational or medical needs

PRIMARY REQUIREMENTS

1. Education & Experience

- Experience working with children
- Formal training from a Bible College or Seminary is preferred but **not required**

2. Competencies

- Demonstrate the ability to lead (Psalm 78:72)
- Demonstrate the ability to teach the Word of God to children (2 Timothy 4:2)
- Demonstrate the ability to work with others (Philippians 1:27)
- Demonstrate the ability to effectively administer ministries (Titus 1:5)

3. Commitment

- Committed, mature follower of Jesus Christ
- Committed to living for God's glory and the good of his people
- Committed to loving both the local and the global church
- Committed to demonstrating passion and enthusiasm for evangelizing and disciplining children, forming a partnership with parents in raising up the next generation to love God with all of their heart, soul, mind, and strength.
- Committed to the safety of our children, including having a current Criminal Record Check
- Committed to growing as a Christian

RESPONSIBILITIES

Children's Ministry (Age 0 - Grade 5)

- Provide leadership to our Kids Ministry Programs on Sundays, Wednesdays (Exodus 18:13-27, Mark 10:42-45)
- Work with two other churches to run a week-long, half-day Kids Bible Camp
- Work with the leadership to create a comprehensive discipleship pathway from Nursery through to Grade 6 (Colossians 1:28, Deuteronomy 6:4-9)
- Identify, train, equip, and oversee volunteers to do the work of the ministry (Ephesians 4:11-13)
- Pray for children, parents, and the church (Philippians 1:3-11, Ephesians 3:14-21, John 6:44)
- Help disciple and equip parents to bring their children up in the knowledge and discipline of the Lord (Ephesians 6:1-4)
- Teach both children and parents God's Word (Colossians 1:28, 1 Corinthians 1:23, Acts 20:27, Titus 1:9)

- Equip volunteers and structure ministries to evangelize to children both inside (e.g., intentional Sunday curriculum) and outside (e.g., Wednesday Kids Night Out, Kids Bible Camp) of the church (Mark 16:15)
- Communicate clearly and effectively with parents, volunteers, and children, including the effective administration of ministries and the necessity to build strong relationships with parents and children. (Titus 1:5)
- Work to maintain unity and grow multi-generational relationships within the church (Titus 2)
- Oversee our Child & Youth Protection program, leading annual training sessions, managing the collection of criminal record checks, and evaluating the program to ensure it is meeting our needs (Psalm 82:3-4)
- Take on occasional additional responsibilities in collaboration with the staff on larger projects (i.e., volunteer appreciation night, Christmas and Easter services).
- Attend biweekly staff meetings and work as part of the staff team.
- Work under the leadership of the Lead Pastor.
- Participate in the life of the church, growing in relationship with the congregation.
