We were thrilled to be a part of our friends' wedding, which took place on the Saturday following the training and before camp started. (I was physically there, and Mike was there in his thoughts and prayers, as he had already arrived in Canada.) Mihai, the one baptized in Lunca Vita and being discipled by Mike, was married to one of the ladies I have been working with over the past couple of years. What a wonderful celebration and a God honouring ceremony.

### Camp:

Thank you for all your prayers for the camp. The Lord gave us safety as we traveled to and from the camp on train for 7 hours. The Lord even provided an opportunity for one of the younger counselors and one of the younger children to share the gospel with an older couple sitting across from them. The Lord was at work in the camp. Where the Lord is doing a work, Satan is not silent. Although the camp was not without some challenges, it was great to see the Lord at work in the lives of some of the children. We pray as they returned to their homes the songs, verses, lessons, and godly examples of daily living will continue to have an impact in their lives and in the lives of their families.
